Dear friends,

As we enter September we will be beginning our regular worship schedule on September 18th. This is also the day Sunday School will begin. As I thought about moving into this new program year I was reminded of an old story I heard many years ago when attending a church related conference. The speaker began by telling us this story.

"Many years ago," he said, "there was an elderly dairy farmer in Wisconsin whose dairy herd had produced a fine living for he and his family through the years. Throughout the years their shelter had been an old barn in which they would gather, particularly during cold weather or some withering winter storms. One night he thought about doing something special for his milk cows. He thought, "I know what I'll do. I'll build them a fine barn, one that is insulated and can have the temperature at a level to keep them warm and comfortable on those stormy nights."

The next summer he built his barn. It was the talk of the neighborhood. Then he tore down the old barn leaving only the foundation stones in place.

When winter came he waited until a night when the winds were howling and the snow was piling up to go out and see how his animals liked their new shelter.

He was shocked to find the cattle not in the new, comfortable and warm facility but standing outside, huddled together, in the place the old barn had previously stood. He could see them standing there within the confines of the old foundation stones. Even though he tried that night and for several nights afterwards to chase them into the new barn; in the morning he would always find them back in that familiar setting.

The speaker said, the moral of this story is "old habits die hard." My hope is that this year each of you will continue to keep Sunday morning Sunday School and Worship high on your list of priorities. That those times will become habitual for you.

I say this because Sunday mornings need to be, as much as possible, seen as a time to have your spiritual lives revitalized and to have your children taught the about the love and grace of God as revealed to us through God's Son, Jesus Christ.

I say this also because it can provide a time for fellowship with your neighbors and friends over a cup of coffee and a snack. It can be a time to feel, once again, that you are gathered with people who share your faith and who also enjoy being in your presence.

I am excited about a new year with you! Please make every effort to help our respective faith communities be alive and vibrant. It takes each one of us for that to happen.




Dwight Youth Group
