Dear friends,

Transfiguration Sunday is the last Sunday in Epiphany, the last revelation of Jesus' identity as being God's Son until Easter Sunday. On Wednesday, March 2, we will observe our Ash Wednesday services. This is the beginning of the season of Lent, a time when we re-visit our Lord's journey to the Cross. A time we are called to repent in those areas of our lives where we are straying away from what we know, deep down, to be God's will.

One of the appointed texts for preaching on Ash Wednesday is from the book of Joel. The prophet, speaking on behalf of God, says "Return to Me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping and with mourning; and rend your heart and not your garments, and turn to the Lord your God, for God is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in kindness."

Did you notice those words, "rend your heart and not your garments." In other words, God is not looking for some superficial nods in the direction of turning your life around, God is looking for true, genuine repentance, where you and I literally get back on track in our journeys as some of His people. I so appreciate that Joel's call to repentance recalls the reminder that our God is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in kindness." For we are reminded of God's patience with us and God's great love for us. We always need to remember that God's call to repentance is not for God's sake but for ours, so that we might come to know the abundant life God desires us to know.
