WHAT DO WE REMEMBER EACH WEEK OF ADVENT? FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT: HOPE It is sometimes called the "Prophety Candle" in remembrance of the prophets, especially Isalah, who foretold the birth of Christ. THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT: JOY It is called the "Sethlehem Candle" as a reminder of Mary and Joseph's Journey to Bethlehem. FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT: LOVE On the fourth week of Advent, we light the final purple with the Gaudier's Borden and the birth of Jesus, and the birth of our Savior. This final candle, the "Angel's Candle," symbolizes Love. It reminds us that God is love.




