The following selection from "Each New Day" written by Pastor Ken Nyhusmoen, former pastor of Faith/Mooreton has been reprinted with permission.

As the world faced the Coronavirus pandemic of 2020, Pastor Ken Nyhusmoen took to his keyboard, writing inspiring devotionals to share with the people of Desert Hills Lutheran Church of Green Valley, AZ, where he was serving as associate pastor. Many receiving these messages were living alone and appreciated the hopeful messages. Often, they passed them on to family and friends throughout the nation and the world. Pastor Nyhusmoen now makes these devotionals available to everyone in Each New Day: Meditations During Challenging Times. He hopes this book helps bring encouragement and peace through all life's struggles.

I was visiting with my cousin by phone recently and we were reminiscing about the 'good old days. We talked about how we could just hop on bikes and go wherever we wanted. We were as 'free as the birds'! And not only that... we were strong and fit and mighty!

It was shortly after that conversation that I was reading John. Oh my. I came across chapter 21, verse 18. "I am telling you the truth; when you were young, you used to get ready and go anywhere you wanted to; but when you are old, you will stretch out your hands and someone will tie you up and take you where you don't want to go."

Well, here we are. Acceptance. Jesus is telling his friends that they may have to go somewhere they don't want to go. And he is headed to the cross.

My cousin's husband has been ill and has had to go to a nursing home. So after 60+ years of marriage they find themselves... each of them...in places they didn't want to go. I get that. And I struggle for the words to help her get through these times.

Sometimes acceptance is a very difficult thing. When you were young did you ever open up your arms and spin around and around until you just fell to the ground laughing? I remember the freedom of that experience. Now I find myself closing my arms, sometimes even wrapping them around myself and letting the strength and the power of God engulf me. That can be a very freeing experience, as well.

Are there words of courage here from Jesus in John? I think so. We learned so much as children, as we grew and life changed for each of us. We learned that there are so many things we simply cannot change. For one reason or another, life hands us some challenging times. Maybe we can't spin around and let go like we used to, but we can find ourselves in the loving arms of our dear Father. And we accept what it is we cannot change.

I love the hymn, "Breathe on me, Breath of God.... fill me with life anew". It may be a different life then we had planned but we relax in his loving arms as he holds us close.

Remember to wash your hands, fold them and bow your head. Give thanks for this loving God who is the same today as He was yesterday and will be tomorrow.

Pray with me: Heavenly Father, there is so much in life that we struggle to accept. We really would rather have it "our way". Help us to place all our cares and our struggles in your wide open hands. We give thanks for your breath that fills us each and every day new. Thank you, thank you. Amen. In Jesus' Name, Amen.






