Dear Members and Friends of Mooreton Lutheran.

I hope this letter finds you well. We, as church members, have some serious decisions to make. Our current situation is not unique, as many congregations are currently in need of a pastor. The council recently made the decision to hire Pastor Nancy Monke on a short-term, part time basis. Both the call committee and the joint councils have met with her. She is a retired pastor and comes with a good understanding of what we are facing. She will help lead us into the future or guide us through holy closure, but we as members need to take an active part in the process.

She will be here January 5th and 19th and February 16th and 23rd. (She will be with us through May, but specific dates are not yet set). Besides leading worship, she has recommended congregational meetings prior to our service, from 8:00 – 9:00 am. The purpose of those meetings is to get to know us as a congregation, help lead discussions about what our options might be, etc. It is crucial that we, as Mooreton Lutheran members, attend these meetings. There are many aspects to consider and discuss. We need your participation and input to decide the future of our church.

Members of council have worked hard this past year to "fill the pulpit" to provide Sunday worship services this past year. Currently the plan, at least through spring, is to continue to find someone to lead worship on Sundays when Pastor Nancy is not with us.

When our hearts are filled with praise, we need to remember God is faithful.


When our hearts are filled with pain, we need to remember God is faithful.
