Dear Members and Friends of Faith Lutheran.

We hope this letter finds you well. As members of this church, we are confronted with some very serious decisions about our future. While our situation is not unique—many congregations are facing similar challenges in the search for pastoral leadership—this moment is critical, and the choices we make will have a lasting impact on the life of our congregation.

The council has recently made the decision to hire Pastor Nancy Monke on a transitional, part-time basis. Both the call committee and the joint council have had the opportunity to meet with her. As a retired pastor, Pastor Nancy brings a deep understanding of the challenges we are facing. She will help guide us into the future or lead us through a holy closure, but it is crucial that we, as members, actively engage in this process. Our future depends on your involvement.

Pastor Monke will be here January 5 & 19, February 16 & 23 and other dates to be determined through the month of May.

In addition to leading worship, Pastor Nancy has recommended congregational meetings following our services. The purpose of those meetings is to get to know us as a congregation, help lead discussions about what our options might be going forward. It is crucial that we, as Faith Lutheran members, attend these meetings. There are several important aspects to consider and discuss. Your participation and input are essential in deciding the future of our church.

Your Council Presidents have dedicated a significant amount of time and effort this past year to ensure that Sunday worship services continued without interruption. Their commitment to the church has been unwavering as they have worked tirelessly to "fill the pulpit" and provide leadership. For now, the plan is to continue securing worship leaders on Sundays when Pastor Nancy is unavailable, at least through the spring.

When our days are the very worst that they could be, we need to remember God is faithful.


When our hearts are filled with praise, we need to remember God is faithful.
