Dear friends,

It seems such a short time ago that we celebrated the birth of Jesus. Our worship on Christmas Eve focused on how in Jesus the light of the world had been born. And while many pastors reminded their congregations that the shadow of the Cross loomed over the manger bed, the focus was on joy because of the hope that has come to us in the person of Jesus Christ.

Now, the shadow that loomed over the manger bed, has become a reality. As we gather for worship on Palm Sunday and then gather on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday, our Scriptures and hymns are far from joyous. They are certainly beautiful but there is a melancholy feeling about them. How can it be any other way when one sings "Were You There When They Crucified My Lord," or "Beneath the Cross of Jesus."

Thank God, the week of Jesus' Passion did not end with His terrible death on the Cross. Thank God for Easter, for the empty tomb, for the angels' announcement of Jesus' physical resurrection. Thank God for the victory over death that is ours through Christ Jesus our Lord.

In the Christmas hymn "O Little Town of Bethlehem," Philip Brooks says of the birth of Jesus "the hopes and fears of all the years are met in thee tonight." I think the same could be said of the resurrection of Jesus "the hopes and fears of all the years are met in thee this day." Hope won over despair; life over death, light over darkness! Its' been over 2000 years since that first Easter. That little group of disciples went on to turn the world upside down by proclaiming the Lordship of Jesus over all creation. I have a very simple prayer for you and myself. It is that you and I might find ourselves filled from the tip of our toes to the top of our heads with hope. The hope that comes from believing: hope that will not disappoint us!! Have a blessed Easter!
